## Amendment to the Collective Agreement on a Procedure for Job Grading of 19 February 2002

**WHEREAS** the Office and the Union signed on 19 February 2002 a Collective Agreement on a Procedure for Job Grading;

**WHEREAS,** in the light of experience, the Parties consider that in order to ensure a coherent and effective operation of grading procedures, certain concepts and procedural aspects provided for in the Agreement need to be clarified and adjusted;

**WHEREAS** article 9, paragraph 3, of the Agreement, provides that any modification or amendment thereto shall be effected by means of a written agreement signed by the Parties;

**THEREFORE**, the Parties have agreed to amend the Collective Agreement on a Procedure for Job Grading as follows:

## Article 1

The Agreement of 19 February 2002 shall be amended to the extent required by the provisions contained in the Annex to the present Agreement (ILO Series 6 Circular, Job Grading Procedure).

## Article 2

A copy of the Procedure for Job Grading, as hereby amended, shall be notified to each staff member by means of an administrative circular.

## Article 3

This Amendment shall become effective upon its signature by the Parties.
