RESOLUTION

concerning the charges for language courses

The Staff Union of the ILO, convened in its Annual General Meeting on 7 October 1986,

DEPLORING the imposition of charges on officials at headquarters taking language courses,

NOTING that the ILO is the only international organisation in Geneva to have adopted this practice,

NOTING that it is not foreseen to reimburse officials who have paid to attend language courses but who are obliged by their chiefs to miss classes,

INSTRUCTS the Staff Union Committee to pursue its action to obtain the abolition of these charges and, at the same time, to pursue its demand that resources be made available so that a training programme worthy of the ILO may at last be established.
